#### **Dear Friends**

Project Khemka Rameshwar Lal (AIPAD) was initiated in January 2014 and has successfully completed five years in December 2018. With humility and pride, we would like to share with you that our Project through its direct and indirect impact, has reached out to approx. 12 lakh people in Kahalgaon, Pirpainti, Sanhoula, Shahkund & Jagdishpur blocks of Bhagalpur. We have directly facilitated social security schemes for approx. 32,272 people belonging to the most hard to reach communities. Similarly, maternal health service has been facilitated for approx. 1,30,000 women. Our path breaking pilot in health technology – Swasthya Slate/Health Cube has helped in conducting approx. 80,000 ante natal tests at the door steps of women in rural Bhagalpur. Approx. 1,61,000 toilets were constructed in the course of last five years. Project through its various initiatives has impacted approx. 4,60,000 **children** studying in schools and anganwadis. These achievements would not have been possible without strong collaborations and support of various stakeholders in Bhagalpur. The district administration of Bhagalpur, Panchayati Raj Institution Members,

various line departments and communities have walked shoulder to shoulder with us in this journey. To further quantify the magnitude of this collaboration, it is important to mention here that approx. **5,500 stakeholders** from the above mentioned groups were trained to become the torch bearers of change.

To carry the mantle forward, we end this project cycle leaving behind 46 model villages, 5 information centres, 52 functional advocacy groups, 5 kshetriyay samities and 1 district federation in Bhagalpur. We sincerely hope that this journey of change continues in the years to come abiding by the principles of cooperation, collaboration, transparency and accountability. Community's primary stakeholdership leading to its consciousness and ability of accountable monitoring has been our greatest learning in these 5 years.

On behalf of the Nand & Jeet Khemka Foundation, the Khemka Family & Team AIPAD we take this opportunity to thank European Union for their incessant support in realizing the goals and objectives of our project. We would like to thank Nidan for being an equal partner in this mission and jointly owning all the achievements as well as challenges with us. We would extend our gratitude to the Nabha Foundation for fulfilling our training

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needs. District Administration & District Health Society of Bhagalpur, Block Development Offices and Primary Health Centres of Kahalgaon, Pirpainti, Sanhoula, Shahkund & Jagdishpur and many other Government Representatives have been our integral partners and pillars of support in this endeavor. Their leadership, critical inputs, openness to change and new ideas, has helped us deepen and widen the systemic impact. Our strongest partners on ground zero have been the communities and their panchayat representatives, without whom even the smallest of achievements would not have been possible. I hope that this collaborative spirit continues towards improving the living conditions of the people of Bhagalpur. All synergised efforts should be geared towards creating a model for aware and responsible citizenry and accountable governance. It should hopefully serve as a constructive example that can be replicated throughout the country.


